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Students and Scholars of the Holy Bible; **Grace to You!**

I put pen to paper to cast on the canvas of your mind, God's edit in reference to His Holy Word. My meditation theme:

***GOD'S WARNING AGAINST
CHANGING HIS HOLY WORD!***

God says:

You shall not add to the word which I command you, nor take from it, that you may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you (Deuteronomy 4:2-NKJV).

This same warning against adding to or abridging God's Law is repeated in Deuteronomy; *"Whatever I command you, be careful to observe it; You shall not add to it nor take away from it" (Deuteronomy 12:32-NKJV).*

This passage is absolutely stating a fact and without the need of exegesis, which is "to give a clear and concise explanation of the text in its original setting." This is firm and is God's warning against adding, subtracting, deletion, and or distorting His Holy Word. Further, *"Do not add to His words, Lest He rebuke you, and you be found a liar" (Proverbs 30:6-NKJV).*

Supplementing God's Word with mankind's speculations, opinions, and self-centered desire is foolish business, and sinfully disobeying God. This same warning shows up in the book of Revelation: *If anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book" ----- (Revelation 22:19-NKJV).*

God shall take away his part from the book of Life. What should God's clergymen do about these firm statements? Do we obey God's Word, or give our opinions and or philosophical dissertation about His word? Often saying "that was in Paul's day, as though it has changed in our times." The time in which we live has no bearing on the truth of the Holy Bible. The sinful actions and behavior of some church-going, religious people does not alter God's eternal world.

How will God judge those men who are divinely called by Him, to represent Him? Clergymen, under-shepherds, elders, bishops, and or the declared inserted pastors, and teachers, and lay-leaders should teach, and or preach the whole council of God's eternal Word.

But in their silence of not speaking out against the rise of Satanic lead religious people, whether ignorant of willfully usurping certain biblical prescribed positions, they should be chided, and their error called out publicly that all may fear to disobey God's Word.

The silence of biblically called and commissioned yoke-men of the divine order, are endorsing or accepting their disobedience by silence and is a failure to obey God's Word completely. Further, those who are led to disobey God's Word are on the rise everywhere, and clergy preachers and teachers are failing to contend for the whole Council of God's eternal Word (Jude 3).

The people of God everywhere should not do as the eminent apostle Paul directed the Ephesians Saints to do:

Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all supplication for all saints—and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak (Ephesians 6:18–20–NKJV).

Note that even in prison, Paul was not thinking of his own personal welfare but of the testimony for Christ Jesus. He was in chains, but he still "*contend for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints*" (Jude 3).

When God declared: *And I will give you shepherds according to My heart, who will feed you with knowledge and understanding* (Jeremiah 3:15–NKJV), He was letting the whole world know that his epoch, (this present church age) would have divinely given men who would teach and preach with knowledge and understanding of the truth.

Many religious church-going people in this epoch of history are on the threshold of the Lord Christ's soon return (I Thessalonians 4:13–18), and are acting like His coming is not soon. Thus, the disobedient ones are carrying on their sinful act without punishment.

I contend that there is a hush and cry of both young and older saints, and non-saints seeking the truth, and are wondering where to find the answer. God gives an answer, and we, the righteousness must not be silent in our contending for the truth of the blessed Word of God.

We, the righteous according to His Word cannot afford to be silent any longer. Have you ever heard people say: "I know what the Lord said to me even if it is condemned in the Holy Bible?"

While others will say, "well I don't know what the Lord said to a person about their clear dissidence to His Word of God", in reference to biblical positions in the Lord's divinely ordained position in the local parish church.

Just as long as they are singing and shouting to music in any gathered place, does not mean that they are on solid biblical ground. The only way they are going to know the truth from God's blueprint—the Holy Bible, whether it is forbidden or allowed, is to examine His word.

I ask, "Who will be bold enough to speak the truth? Whether clergyman, or lay-saints? We are all Servants (Mashiach) of God, but not all are given the same gifts (I Corinthians 12:1–14:40).

It is clear, the Holy Bible does not contradict itself; because the Holy Bible is God breathed. It is God who called and ordained 40-men to put pen to Papyrus and declare what He says to them without error.

Therefore, "Who will be bold enough to take a stand in this dark age of Satanic infiltration into the church with his devilish agenda?"

We saints should always hold firm to the statement: “Whatever the Holy Bible teaches is believed, or nothing it teaches is believed.”

The “born again” (Spirit Baptized) Christians who are evangelical, orthodox believers of the Holy Faith are those who adhere to the 66–canonical books of the Holy Bible which includes the “Three–In–One of the Godhead.” Namely God (YAHWEH), the Father Jesus–(YESHUA), the only begotten Son; and The Holy Spirit, (NESHAMIACH, RUACH). There is a lingering desire to be accepted for something we are or have done. But righteousness by faith is God’s way and the only way.

Is there a difference between the gift of faith to believe the first time and faith that is one of the gifts of the Spirit in (I Corinthians 12)? YES. The difference is that one provides a right relationship with God, and the other equips the saints to minister for God.

The quality of faith given to a person to believe in God is the special gift of faith after we have become “born again” is to trust God courageously with situations, circumstances, people, and impossibilities. Faith as the gift of the Holy Spirit and is the capacity to dare to believe that all things are possible if willed by God.

We saints should pray for it and thank God in advance for it. The gift gives us a daring boldness to expect miracles. Years ago, I decided that I will follow the cadences of Christ Jesus, my new Drummer. All of life is a gift because the Lord provided the Lamb of Calvary. **What you do for God gives Him pleasure!**
